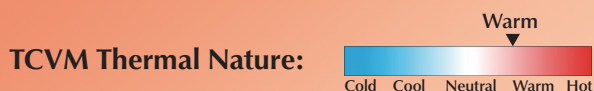

Ingredients and Actions:

Ingredient	Actions
<i>Dang Gui</i>	Activate Blood, Resolve Stasis, Relieve Stagnation
<i>Yan Hu Suo</i>	Move Qi/Blood, Resolve Stasis, Relieve Stagnation
<i>Chi Shao</i>	Relieve Stagnation, Cool Blood
<i>Chuan Xiong</i>	Relieve Stagnation, Activate Blood
<i>Du Huo</i>	Relieve Stagnation, Dispel Wind-Damp
<i>Mo Yao</i>	Move Blood, Relieve Stagnation
<i>Qiang Huo</i>	Relieve Stagnation, Activate Blood
<i>Ru Xiang</i>	Move Blood, Relieve Stagnation
<i>Bu Gu Zhi</i>	Benefit Back, Tonify Yang
<i>Chuan Niu Xi</i>	Benefit Bones and Limbs
<i>Du Zhong</i>	Benefit Back, Tonify Yang
<i>Hong Hua</i>	Break Down Blood Stasis, Relieve Stagnation
<i>Ji Xue Teng</i>	Nourish Blood
<i>Tao Ren</i>	Break Down Blood Stasis, Relieve Stagnation
<i>Tu Si Zi</i>	Nourish Kidney and Liver
<i>Yin Yang Huo</i>	Tonify Kidney Yang and Yin

Contraindications: Do not use during pregnancy.

Product	Species	Directions for use or as suggested by a veterinarian
200 Teapill	canine, feline	1-2 pills per 10 lbs bw; bid
Regular Powder 200g or 600g	canine, feline	0.5g per 10 to 20 lbs bw; bid
	equine	10 to 20g; bid
Concentrated 90g or 180g	canine, feline	½ to 1 small scoop per 10 to 20 lbs bw; bid
	equine	2½ large scoops (3g); bid
Conc. Capsule 100-0.5g	canine, feline	1 capsule per 20 to 40 lbs bw; bid
Conc. Capsule 50-0.2g	canine, feline	1 capsule for small dog/cat <10 lbs; sid
Conc. 7500mg Tincture	canine, feline	10 drops per 5 to 10 lbs bw; bid

lb=pound; bw=body weight; bid=twice daily; sid=once daily
